Truck Festival background

Born in 1998, Truck is a two-day music festival organized predominantly by the local community. The Hill Farm site now has a capacity of 6,000 and the festival has the reputation of being one of the UK's most musically eclectic, as well as being a relaxing and family-friendly event. Truck aims to remain ethical and accessible to all. The food is cheap (from the local Rotary Club) and the vicar sells ice creams in aid of local projects. The festival attracts people of all ages, including interested locals as well as music fans from all over the country.

Over the last few years Truck tickets have sold out in advance.

Truck has donated over £100,000 to local and national charities in recent years and continues to support charitable work. Benefactors have included the Mali Development Fund and various other locally based charities working with young people.

Reviews and previews from previous years have appeared in The Independent, The Guardian, The Sunday Times, Time Out, and on John Peel, Mark and Lard and Jo Wiley radio shows.

Market trading at Truck Festival

Truck is ideal for stalls trading clothing, art, crafts, gifts, and relaxation services as well as for charities wishing to promote current campaigns.

We aim not to book a variety of traders and not to overlap greatly in any one area of merchandise/service.

Pitches are available in the **market field** and **Corn Alley**.

The market field (between the main field and the campsite) contains the acoustic stage, the kids' tent, Butt's real ale bar, theatre and chill-out zone, craft marquee, and around forty stalls of merchandise and charities. The acoustic tent has increased greatly in popularity over recent years and is now one of the main festival attractions.

Corn Alley, next to the main food stands, is the only thoroughfare from main field to market field/campsite and houses approximately 10 traders. Corn Alley closes overnight from 3am so may offer a more peaceful night's sleep than in the market field which is open to the public through the night! Pitches in Corn Alley are limited in number.

Unfortunately we are not accepting applications for stalls selling food, drink, or CDs and records.

Stall prices

NB:

1. Truck Enterprises is VAT registered and the above prices **DO NOT** include VAT at 17.5%. Please add 17.5% VAT to the above prices before submitting your fee. VAT invoices/ receipts available upon request.
2. Cheques payable to 'Truck Enterprises'.
3. Stall dimensions must **include** any space used for camping and/or vehicles behind your stall. Alternatively, you may camp separately from your stall at the price stated under 'Extras'.
4. Pitch prices in the craft marquee include the hire of the stated number of trestle tables (6'x2'6") to stalls. Space behind tables in the craft marquee will be between 4ft and 6ft. There is no space for you to bring your own tables or any vehicle into the marquee, but you will need to **bring your own chairs**.
5. Basic pitch prices are for the whole weekend (site open to stallholders from midday Friday to midday Monday) and include entry for 2 people and the necessary vehicle/ car park passes.

Regulations and further information

1. At least half your total fee (including 17.5% VAT not quoted in the prices above) must be sent with your application to hold your place if accepted. We will collect any balance at the festival. Cheques must be made payable to 'Truck Enterprises'.
2. Deposit required when hiring trestle tables from us is a £40 cheque per table (separate from stall fee cheque) not cashed unless necessary after the festival.
3. You may not use your own generators. Electricity can be provided to outdoor stalls for an extra £40. If you are hiring power from us, you must bring a max. 16amp CeeForm cable with you. (These are the blue waterproof camping style cables). No domestic sockets allowed. Electrical equipment must be PAT tested and you must send the certificate with your application. You must bring your own fire extinguisher if appropriate for your electrical equipment. You must let us know your power requirements (type of connection and watts or list of appliances to be powered) with this application.
4. We cannot provide cover for outdoor stalls.
5. We cannot provide water to stalls.
6. Tent and campervan camping are available separate from your stall for £10 and £15 respectively. Alternatively you may camp by your stall if you include the necessary space in the stall dimensions.
7. You must give accurate measurements for the dimensions of your stall which must include any space required for camping/ vehicles behind the stall. You will not be allowed any more space than you state on the application form.
8. You will be allowed to keep your vehicle with your stall so long as it does not move for the duration of the festival (9am Saturday to 9am Monday). Alternatively you may leave your vehicle in the car park (approx. 200m from the market field/ Corn Alley) where you may move it in and out freely throughout the festival. There is to be absolutely no movement of trader vehicles in the market field between 9am Saturday and 9am Monday. If ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY you may arrange to move your vehicle to leave the festival between 7pm and 8pm on Sunday evening by prior arrangement with the stalls coordinator.
9. Ticket holders will be allowed into the campsite from 5pm on Friday and to the main event from 9am Saturday until midday on Monday.
10. Stallholders may arrive midday-10pm Friday and 7am-8.30am Saturday.
11. Stalls must be trading at least 9am to 6pm on Saturday and 10am to 6pm Sunday.
12. The selling of alcohol, abusive or illegal substances, or anything presenting a fire hazard (including sky lanterns) or other danger to the public is forbidden. Anyone found doing so will be removed from the site without a refund.
13. No glass, dogs, or fires (including candles with naked flames) are allowed on site.
14. Small stereos are permitted on outdoor stalls during trading times but must be kept to a reasonable volume and must be turned off immediately if requested by the organisers. No stereos are permitted on indoor stalls.
15. Stallholders must provide a copy of their public liability insurance with this application.
16. All marquees and tents used for stalls must be fire-proof. If you do not have a fire certificate, your tent may be flame tested. (You should be able to fire-proof your tents prior to the event with fire-proofing spray if necessary).
17. Though there will be a security presence at the festival all belongings and merchandise will be brought/ left at your own risk.
18. Stallholders in the craft marquee will need to bring their own chairs.
19. Charity stallholders must stay on their stand and not walk round the site with publicity material.
20. All stalls, however small, must supply a risk assessment with their application. A template is available at www.thisistruck.com.
21. All stalls must send a £40 'environmental bond' deposit cheque with their application, separate from the pitch fee. This will be held by the stalls coordinator and would only be banked after the event if you leave the site littered or in any way damaged. All rubbish must be placed in the bins provided or taken away from the site, and any larger items (eg broken gazebos/ tents/ banners/ notice boards) must be taken away with you as we do not have the capacity to dispose of them.

1. Completed, signed and dated application form (p.5 of this document).
2. Copy of your public liability insurance. If this is due to be renewed between now and the festival please send a copy of your current cover now and a copy of the renewed cover when it is available.
3. Risk assessment (template available at www.thisistruck.com).
4. PAT certificates for any electrical equipment you will be using.
5. Fire certificates for any tents/ gazebos you will be using.
6. Power requirements if hiring power from us (what amp connection you will be using or the number of watts you will be using, or if you do not know either of these, a list of appliances you will be running with the power and their wattage).
7. Cheque for at least half the total fee including extras, including 17.5% VAT added to the prices listed above, payable to 'Truck Enterprises'.
8. Separate cheque for £40 'environmental bond' deposit, payable to 'Truck Enterprises'.
9. Separate deposit cheque for £40 if hiring trestle tables for outdoor stalls, payable to 'Truck Enterprises'.
